A brambly, sappy pinot that has an earthy and strongly savory overall feel to it. Fragrant herbs, orange zest, pot-pourri and dried cherries with abundant baking spices, leading to a palate with a central thread of savory tannins carrying spicy dried cherries. Drink or hold.

## 2016 Marion's Vineyard Pinot Noir

This has a very pure, natural feel with an array of ripe, spicy red cherries and berries, as well as a sappy, undergrowth thread. The palate is beautifully rendered on long, earthy tannins and a juicy, deep-set finish. Drink or hold.

#### 2014 Con Brio

An array of ripe and spicy aromas and flavors here. Dried cherries, plums and licorice run on smooth, even, succulent tannins. A blend of syrah, merlot and pinot noir. Drink now.

#### 2015 Syrah

Plenty of pepper and spice adorn the ripe blackberries and wild raspberries. The palate has a savory core of dried black-fruit flavors with abundant pepper and spice notes. Sturdy finish. Good depth and power here. Drink or hold.
